Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Compliance with plan. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 48; Approval of the plan of care.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>62. (10)</b> The licensee shall ensure that the care services that the licensee provides to the resident are set out in the plan of care and are provided to the resident in accordance with the plan and the prescribed requirements, if any.</p> <p><b>62. (12)</b> The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,</p> <p><b>48. (1)</b> For the purposes of paragraph 2 of subsection 62 (9) of the Act and subject to subsection (2), the licensee shall ensure that a resident's plan of care is approved by,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) a person acting under the supervision of a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario or the College of Nurses of Ontario.</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The listed items had not been addressed in relation to some residents' plans of care.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>

**2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 29; Administration of drugs or other substances.**

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**29.** If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the administration of a drug or other substance, the licensee shall ensure that,  
(d) a member of a College, as defined in the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991, supervises the administration of the drug or other substance to the resident in the home.

**Inspection Finding**

The Licensee failed to provide supervision of medication administration by a member of a Regulated Health Professional.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**3. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.**

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**27. (5)** The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,  
(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,  
(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act.

**Inspection Finding**

The Licensee failed to ensure that all staff wear eye protection when providing direct care within 2 m of a resident.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location.
