Order Information: The Deputy Registrar issued a Compliance Order under section 90 of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "Act") to the Licensee. The Deputy Registrar believes on reasonable grounds that the Licensee contravened section 39 of the Act, by failing to comply with conditions placed on the Licensee's licence which require the Licensee to hire a person with experience in a senior position at a licensed retirement home in Ontario to manage the Home. The Licensee also failed to comply with subsection 62(12)(b) of the Act and subsection 23(1) of the Regulation, as the Licensee could not demonstrate that all resident plans of care had been revised in the prescribed timeframe, and the Licensee failed to fully implement its behaviour management strategy for a resident. Further, the Deputy Registrar believes the Licensee contravened certain sections of the Regulation with respect to medication administration including with respect to training of staff, keeping proper Medication Administration Records (MARs), evidence of resident prescriptions and preparing written records of medication errors. The Order requires the Licensee to complete all resident plans of care; including behaviour management strategies for any resident who poses a risk to themselves or other residents, and retrain all staff who administer drugs in the administration of those drugs, the preparation of MARs and written records of medication errors.
