Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 47; Development of plan of care.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

47. (4) Subject to subsections (5) and (6), a plan of care for a resident is complete if the plan, (b) sets out,

(i) any information that is necessary to allow the licensee's staff to understand the resident's needs and preferences, including cultural, spiritual and religious preferences and customary routines.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to complete a plan of care as required.

Outcome

The Licensee had advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 36; Continence care.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

36. (1) If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is continence care, the licensee shall establish a continence care program that includes,

(c) toileting programs;

(d) strategies to maximize the resident's independence, comfort and dignity, including the use of equipment, supplies, devices and assistive aids.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to establish a continence care program as prescribed.

Outcome

The Licensee had advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.
