Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

## NON-COMPLIANCE

# 1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 75; Reporting certain matters to Registrar.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>75. (1)</u> A person who has reasonable grounds to suspect that any of the following has occurred or may occur shall immediately report the suspicion and the information upon which it is based to the Registrar:
3. Unlawful conduct that resulted in harm or a risk of harm to a resident.

#### Inspection Finding

Evidence shows that the home had reasonable grounds to suspect that illegal activity occurred and conducted a comprehensive investigation into the alleged illegal activity, including notifying the police. Even though the homes investigation resulted in a lack of insufficient evidence to confirm the allegation, the home failed to report the allegation to the RHRA.

#### Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

## 2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 40; Provision of a meal.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>40.</u> If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is the provision of a meal, the licensee shall ensure that,



(g) the resident is informed of his or her daily and weekly menu options;

#### **Inspection Finding**

The Licensee continues to fail to ensure that the residents are informed of their daily and weekly menu options. The menus are posted; however, the posted menus are not followed and do not correspond with what is being served for the meal that was observed at the inspection.

#### Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.
