Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 118; False information.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>118. No person shall knowingly provide false or misleading information to an inspector, the Registrar or any person employed or retained by the Authority in any statement or document in respect of any matter relating to this Act or the regulations, whether made or given orally, on paper or electronically.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>During the course of the inspection, a staff member knowingly provided false information to an inspector as it pertained to the dates the staff member tended to a resident.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Same, neglect.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>67. (2) Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that the licensee and the staff of the home do not neglect the residents.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>At the time of inspection, evidence revealed that the Licensee failed to ensure a resident was not neglected.</p>

Staff failed to adequately assess a resident which resulted in an unnecessary delay in required medical attention.

Outcome


The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
