Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">62. (12) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">(b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>A review of resident plans of care indicated non-compliance with the requirement to update a resident plan of care at the time the resident's care needs changed.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">24. (4) The licensee shall keep current all arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency.</p>

24. (5) The licensee shall,

- (a) on an annual basis at least, test the emergency plan, including arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency, related to,
 - (iii) medical emergencies.

Inspection Finding

At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance as it had not completed the annual mandatory drill in relation to medical emergencies. The Licensee has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance. In addition, the Licensee’s emergency plan did not contain current arrangements with emergency partners.

Outcome

At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.

3. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; On-going training. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 14; Staff training.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

65. (4) The licensee shall ensure that the persons who are required to receive the training described in subsection (2) receive on-going training as described in that subsection at the times required by the regulations.

14. (2) For the purposes of subsection 65 (4) of the Act, the licensee shall ensure that the persons who are required to receive training under subsection 65 (2) of the Act receive the training at least annually.

Inspection Finding

A review of the Licensee’s training records revealed that the Licensee failed to ensure that all staff were trained annually, as required.

Outcome


The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
