Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 36; Continence care.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>36. (1)</u> If one of the care services that the licensee or the staff of a retirement home provide to a resident of the home is continence care, the licensee shall establish a continence care program that includes,

(a) measures to promote continence;

(c) toileting programs;

(d) strategies to maximize the resident's independence, comfort and dignity, including the use of equipment, supplies, devices and assistive aids.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to provide a continence care program for a resident to promote continence, or develop toileting programs and strategies to maximize the resident's independence.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by October 1, 2021. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

62. (12) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and



revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident, (b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to ensure that a resident whose care needs changed was reassessed and the plan of care revised to reflect the change in the resident's care needs.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by October 1, 2021. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection

3. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

23. (1) Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop and implement a written behaviour management strategy that includes,

(a) techniques to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

(b) strategies for interventions to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

(c) strategies for monitoring residents that have demonstrated behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

(d) protocols for how staff and volunteers shall report and be informed of resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home.

23. (2) The licensee shall ensure that all staff who provide care services to residents are advised at the beginning of every shift of each resident whose behaviours require heightened monitoring because those behaviours pose a risk to the resident or others in the home.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee did not develop and implement a behaviour management strategy for a resident who was exhibiting behaviours that posed a risk to the resident and others in the home.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by October 1, 2021. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection
