# **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA conducts compliance inspections as set out in section 77(1) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- **27. (9)** The licensee shall ensure that each staff member who works in the retirement home receives training on how to reduce the incidence of infectious disease transmission, including,
  - (a) the need for and method of maintaining proper hand hygiene and method of preventing cross contamination, including proper handling of soiled linens, the protection of uniforms, and the separation of clean and dirty items;
  - (b) the need for and process of reporting, providing surveillance of and documenting incidents of infectious illness.

## **Inspection Finding**

There was no proof that the staff had IPAC training prior to starting to work, nor was there evidence that all staff had annual IPAC training.

#### Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by December 30, 2021. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

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# 27. (5) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,

(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,

(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,

(0.a) any guidance, advice or recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health are followed in the retirement home;

# **Inspection Finding**

There was no evidence of a vaccination policy nor was the visitor policy updated. The IPAC training for staff and essential visitors were not completed as directed. Furthermore, the Residents are not being screened upon return from absences.

### **Outcome**

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by November 30, 2021. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.
