Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 32; Records.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>32. If the licensee or a member of the staff of a retirement home administers a drug or other substance to a resident, the licensee shall ensure that,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(b) if a drug is administered, there is written evidence that the drug was prescribed for the resident by a person who is authorized to prescribe a drug under section 27 of the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991;</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>At the time of the inspection the home failed to produce written evidence of prescriptions for drugs administered by staff to one resident. The home has been in non-compliance in this area at a previous inspection.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by January 31, 2022. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 14; Staff training.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p>

14. (1) For the purposes of clause 65 (2) (j) of the Act, every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that all staff who work in the home receive training in the procedure described in subsection 73 (1) of the Act for a person to complain to the licensee.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to ensure that staff were trained in the procedure for a person to complain to the licensee prior to starting work in the home.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by January 31, 2022. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

**3. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.
The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 25; Emergency plan, retirement home with more than 10 residents.**

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

24. (4) The licensee shall keep current all arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency.

24. (5) The licensee shall,
(b) at least once every two years, conduct a planned evacuation of the retirement home;

25. (3) The licensee shall ensure that the emergency plan provides for the following:
3. Resources, supplies and equipment vital for the emergency response being set aside and readily available at the retirement home and regular testing of all such resources, supplies and equipment to ensure that they are in working order.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to keep a written record of an evacuation that was held at the home. In addition, the home did not keep current arrangements with partners related to accommodation in responding to an emergency. Furthermore, the home failed to keep supplies and equipment set aside and readily available, including regular testing to ensure they are in good working order.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by January 31, 2022. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location.
