Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>27. (5)</b> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,            (0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,            (i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The licensee failed to take all reasonable steps in the retirement home to follow, any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health. Specifically, the Licensee failed to ensure that staff were wearing proper medical masks and failed to properly screen visitors prior to entering the home.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
<p><b>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b>23. (2)</b> The licensee shall ensure that all staff who provide care services to residents are advised at the beginning of every shift of each resident whose behaviours require heightened monitoring because those behaviours pose a risk to the resident or others in the home.</p>

**Inspection Finding**

The Licensee failed to comply with their behaviour management policy. Specifically, the Home failed to document and communicate to all staff incidents of behaviours exhibited by a resident that could pose a risk to other residents.

**Outcome**

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
