

# FINAL INSPECTION REPORT Under the Retirement Homes Act, 2010

#### **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- **23. (1)** Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop and implement a written behaviour management strategy that includes,
  - (a) techniques to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;
  - (b) strategies for interventions to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;
  - (c) strategies for monitoring residents that have demonstrated behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

#### **Inspection Finding**

The inspector reviewed a sample of resident care files and found 3 residents with behavioural issues that were not included in their plan of care and further that no behaviour strategies or techniques were being implemented to monitor, assess and manage the behaviours exhibited

#### Outcome

The Licensee advises that it has taken corrective action to meet compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.

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Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>62. (12)</u> The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,

(b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;

## **Inspection Finding**

The inspector reviewed a sample of resident care files and found that 3 residents did not have their plans of care updated as care needs changed or at least every six months. The Licensee failed to ensure that the plans of care were updated and completed to reflect the residents care needs.

#### Outcome

The Licensee has advised that corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection
