Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 67; Same, neglect.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>67. (2)</u> Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that the licensee and the staff of the home do not neglect the residents.

Inspection Finding

The Licensee failed to ensure that a resident was not neglected relating to a urine void test and the removal of the residents catheter for an inappropriate length of time. This resulted in the resident experiencing severe pain and requiring hospitalization.

Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 65; Obligations of licensees re staff.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>65. (1)</u> Every licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that all the staff who work in the home,(a) have the proper skills and qualifications to perform their duties;

Inspection Finding



The Licensee could not provide documentation showing that staff members providing catheter care to a resident had received training in catheter care.

Outcome

The Licensee has submitted a plan to achieve compliance by April 15, 2022. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection.



NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location.
