Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts compliance inspections as set out in section 77(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><u>27. (5)</u> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the inspector's observations and documentation reviewed did not support that the Licensee followed a directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act, as active screening of all visitors was not being completed as required. Further, the Licensee did not ensure that all visits, including the name, contact information, date and time of visit, and resident visited for each visitor was completed as required. The Licensee failed to follow the COVID-19 Directive #3 issued by the Chief Medical Officer of Health.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee has demonstrated it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
