### **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 75; Reporting certain matters to Registrar.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- **75. (1)** A person who has reasonable grounds to suspect that any of the following has occurred or may occur shall immediately report the suspicion and the information upon which it is based to the Registrar:
  - 1. Improper or incompetent treatment or care of a resident that resulted in harm or a risk of harm to the resident.

## **Inspection Finding**

While conducting this inspection, the inspector found evidence that the retirement home had reasonable grounds to suspect that there was improper or incompetent treatment of care that occurred with a resident. Although the retirement home immediately investigated and took appropriate action, they failed to immediately report the suspicion and the information to the RHRA.

#### Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.
