#### **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

#### NON-COMPLIANCE

#### 1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**23. (1)** Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop and implement a written behaviour management strategy that includes,

(a) techniques to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

(b) strategies for interventions to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

#### Inspection Finding

The inspector reviewed a sample of resident care files and found that the Licensee failed to ensure that a written behavior management strategy was developed and implemented, which included techniques and interventions to prevent and address resident behaviors for resident with behaviors that pose a risk of harm to their self or others.

#### Outcome

The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

#### 2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

### 24. (5) The licensee shall,

(b) at least once every two years, conduct a planned evacuation of the retirement home;

### **Inspection Finding**

The inspector reviewed the Licensee's records of a full evacuation and found insufficient evidence that the Licensee completed a full evacuation within the last two years as required.

#### Outcome

The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
