<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>As part of the inspection, the inspector reviewed routine cleaning methods. Through interviews and documentation, there was no evidence of routine cleaning for common areas completed in approximately 5 weeks.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
