# **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

# **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**62. (12)** The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months.

# **Inspection Finding**

During the inspection the Inspector reviewed several residents plans of care. The Inspector determined two residents plans of care had not been updated within the previous six months. The Licensee failed to complete plans of care as prescribed.

#### **Outcome**

At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

24. (5) The licensee shall,

(a) on an annual basis at least, test the emergency plan, including arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency, related to,

- (i) the loss of essential services,
- (ii) situations involving a missing resident,
- (iii) medical emergencies,
- (iv) violent outbursts;

# **Inspection Finding**

During the inspection the Inspector determined that annual testing of the homes emergency plan involving a medical emergency, loss of essential services, a violent outburst and missing resident had not been completed. The Licensee failed to complete annual testing of the emergency plan as prescribed.

## **Outcome**

At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.
