Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts compliance inspections as set out in section 77(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p><b><u>27. (5)</u></b> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,</p> <p>(0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,</p> <p>(i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act.</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>During the inspection the inspector viewed documents and spoke with staff regarding COVID-19 policies and procedures. The inspector found that the Licensee failed to ensure all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow, any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health. Specifically, the Licensee failed to ensure that staff have access to N95 masks at point of care during an outbreak. Additionally, the Licensee failed to screen residents for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 on a daily basis, and failed to update the Home's Visitor Policy to ensure that the Home is complying with the latest directives regarding COVID-19.</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>The Licensee has demonstrated it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by inspection.</p>
