The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").


NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Persons who approve plans of care.</p> <p>The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>62. (9) The licensee shall ensure that the following persons have approved the plan of care, including any revisions to it, and that a copy is provided to them:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The resident or the resident's substitute decision-maker. <p>62. (12) The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>The inspector reviewed a sample of resident care files and found two residents were not reassessed within the required time period. Furthermore, for one resident there was no evidence to demonstrate that the resident or their SDM approved the plan of care.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by August 12, 2022. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection.</p>

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
