## **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- <u>62. (12)</u> The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,
  - (a) a goal in the plan is met;
  - (b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;
  - (c) the care services set out in the plan have not been effective.

## **Inspection Finding**

A report was made to RHRA regarding suspected improper care of a resident. As part of the inspection in response to the report, the inspector reviewed records relating to the resident and interviewed staff, residents, and their substitute decision maker. The inspector confirmed that the Licensee failed to ensure that the resident is reassessed, and the plan of care is reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if there is a change.

#### **Outcome**

At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was not in compliance. The home has since taken corrective action to achieve compliance.
