### **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA conducts routine inspections as set out in section 77(3) of the *Retirement Homes Act, 2010* (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Contents of plan.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- <u>62. (4)</u> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that there is a written plan of care for each resident of the home that sets out,
  - (b) the planned care services for the resident that the licensee will provide, including, (iii) clear directions to the licensee's staff who provide direct care to the resident;

## **Inspection Finding**

As part of the inspection, the inspector observed meal service and witnessed a disruptive behaviour that did not pose risk to the resident or others. The inspector reviewed records relating to the resident and identified that the plan of care was missing clear direction on how to address the disruptive behaviour while providing meals. The Licensee failed to ensure clear direction to the staff in the contents of the plan of care as required.

#### **Outcome**

The Licensee has demonstrated it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance.

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## **NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
