Purpose of Inspection

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

<u>27. (5)</u> The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,

(0.a) any guidance, advice or recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health are followed in the retirement home;

Inspection Finding

A report was made to RHRA regarding suspected improper care of a resident. The hand sanitizer available for use in the area designated for COVID-19 rapid antigen testing did not meet the established requirements.

Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection.

2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 24; Emergency plan, general.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

24. (5) The licensee shall,

(a) on an annual basis at least, test the emergency plan, including arrangements with community agencies, partner facilities and resources that will be involved in responding to an emergency, related to,



(iii) medical emergencies,

Inspection Finding

The evidence provided during the inspection failed to confirm that the section of the emergency plan dealing with medical emergencies was tested as prescribed.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by November 17, 2022. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
