### **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

# The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Plan of care. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Reassessment and revision.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

**62. (1)** When a resident commences his or her residency in a retirement home, the licensee shall, within the prescribed times, ensure that the resident is assessed and that a plan of care is developed based on the assessment and in accordance with this section and the regulations.

**62. (12)** The licensee shall ensure that the resident is reassessed and the plan of care reviewed and revised at least every six months and at any other time if, in the opinion of the licensee or the resident,

(b) the resident's care needs change or the care services set out in the plan are no longer necessary;

#### **Inspection Finding**

A report was made to the RHRA regarding an alleged resident to resident altercation. As part of the inspection in response to the report, the inspector reviewed records relating to the residents, and interviewed both the resident and staff. The inspector found one resident to not have a full assessment completed as required. They also did not have a plan of care since living in the home for approximately 10 months. Additionally, the inspector found one assessment and plan of care to not be revised within 6 months. The inspector confirmed that the Licensee failed to ensure that all residents assessments and plans of care were completed, as required.

### Outcome

The Licensee has demonstrated it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance.



### NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
