

# FINAL INSPECTION REPORT Under the Retirement Homes Act, 2010

## **Purpose of Inspection**

The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the Retirement Homes Act, 2010 (the "RHA").

#### **NON-COMPLIANCE**

1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 23; Behaviour management.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- **23. (1)** Every licensee of a retirement home shall develop and implement a written behaviour management strategy that includes,
  - (a) techniques to prevent and address resident behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;
  - (c) strategies for monitoring residents that have demonstrated behaviours that pose a risk to the resident or others in the home;

### **Inspection Finding**

The RHRA conducted an inspection, resulting from information received that the home was not providing appropriate behaviour management techniques. There is a requirement that the home shall implement behaviour management techniques and strategies for those residents that pose a risk of harm to themselves or others. The Inspector reviewed home charting, interviewed staff members and made observations. The inspection showed that a resident was exhibiting behaviours that posed a risk to themselves. The inspection showed that the home did not implement written techniques and strategies to prevent and address those harmful behaviours. The Licensee failed to implement written behaviour management techniques and strategies as prescribed

## Outcome

The Licensee has advised it has taken corrective action to achieve compliance. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection.

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## **NOTICE**

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location.
