Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA received a report under section 75(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 22; Risk of falls.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>22. (3) If a resident of a retirement home falls in the home in circumstances other than those described in subsection (2) and the licensee or a staff member becomes aware of the fall, the licensee shall ensure that the licensee or a staff member documents the fall, the response to the fall and the corrective actions taken, if any.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>A report was made to RHRA regarding the suspected improper care of a resident post fall. As part of the inspection in response to the report, the inspector reviewed records relating to the home's falls reports, and interviewed staff. The inspector confirmed that the Licensee failed to ensure all falls were documented including the response and corrective action taken.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by April 20, 2023. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with the RHA, S.O. 2010, c. 11, s. 62; Compliance with plan.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>62. (10) The licensee shall ensure that the care services that the licensee provides to the resident are set out in the plan of care and are provided to the resident in accordance with the plan and the prescribed</p>

requirements, if any.

Inspection Finding

A report was made to RHRA regarding the suspected improper care of a resident. As part of the inspection in response to the report, the inspector reviewed resident records including plans of care. The inspector confirmed that the Licensee failed to ensure that the services set out in the plan of care were provided to the resident.

Outcome

The Licensee submitted a plan to achieve compliance by April 25, 2023. RHRA to confirm compliance by following up with the Licensee or by inspection.

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.
