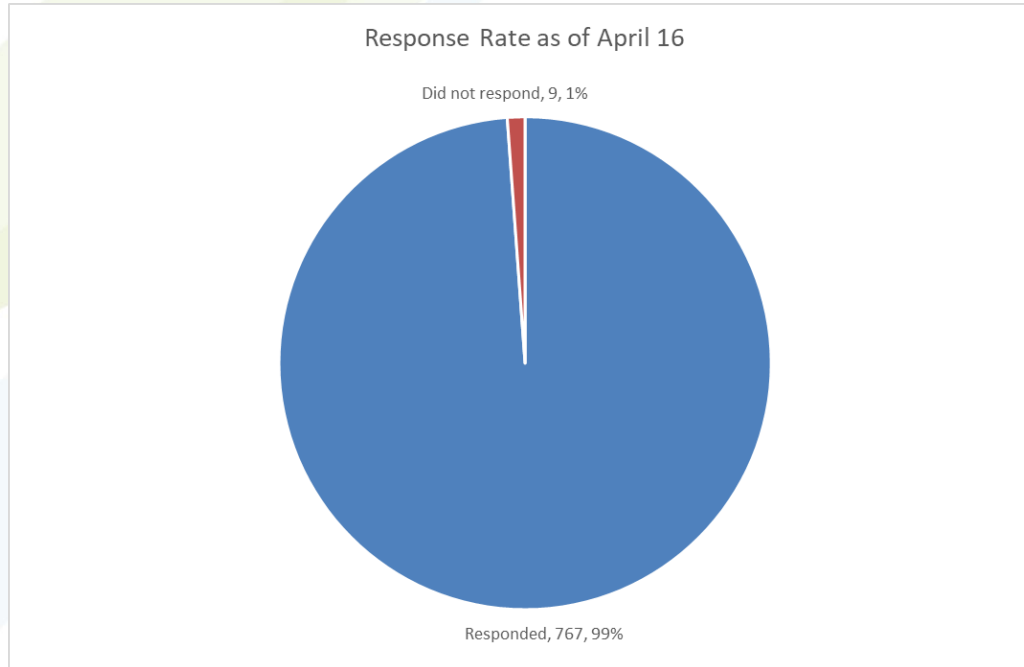
# AIR Overview 2024 - Recap

- First year of new approach to collect information from all licensed retirement homes
- Structured process intended to:
  - Minimize administrative burden on retirement homes
  - Inform the RHRA's regulatory activities and development of right-touch-regulatory model
- Goals for year one:
  - Familiarize the sector with new AIR requirement
  - Link timing of AIR submission to annual fee payment
  - Obtain a better understanding of the sector
- 2024 AIR questions were limited to four questions to support uptake of the new process

# AIR Overview 2024 - Outcome

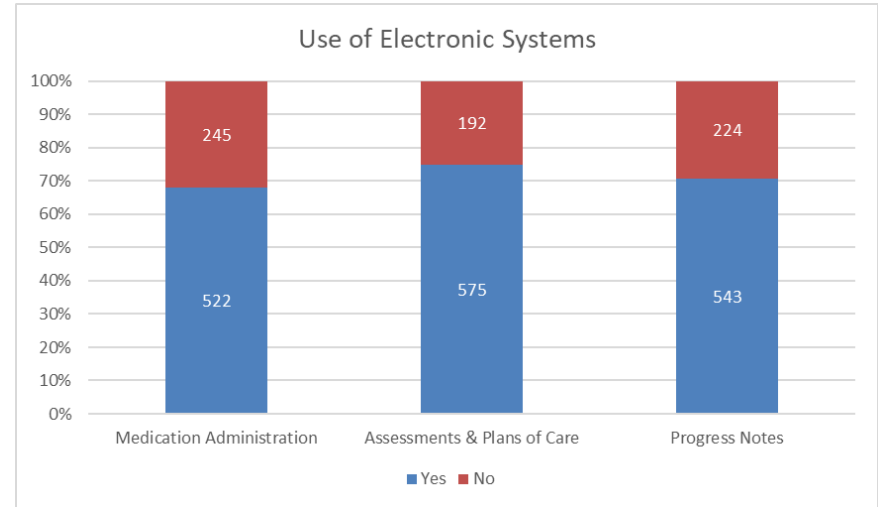
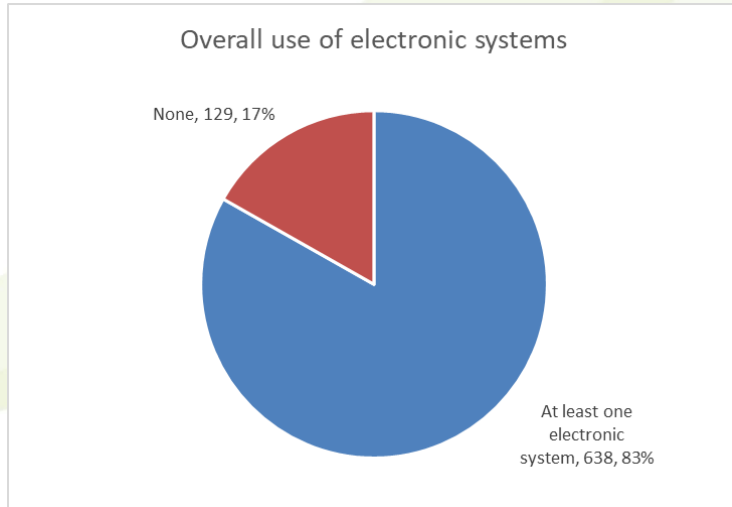
- Results received from **99%** of retirement homes
- Feedback received from retirement home operators provided insight on how the RHRA can improve the AIR process
  - Ex.: have an acknowledgement automatically sent to confirm the submission was successful
- The information received provided valuable insight and a solid foundation to build upon in future years
- Good mechanism using AIR to collect Extra Expense Insurance information

## Overall response: Successful response rate



**Note:** Submissions are a requirement under the Retirement Homes Act. The 9 homes which did not make a submission were follow-up with.

# Electronic systems: Some homes remain paper-based in documenting care

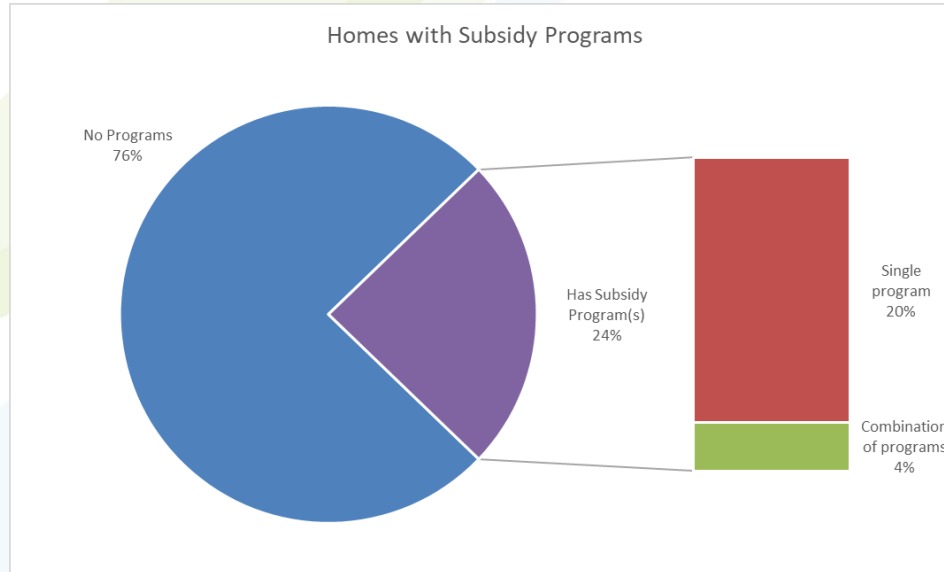


Question:

- Progress Notes (Y/N)

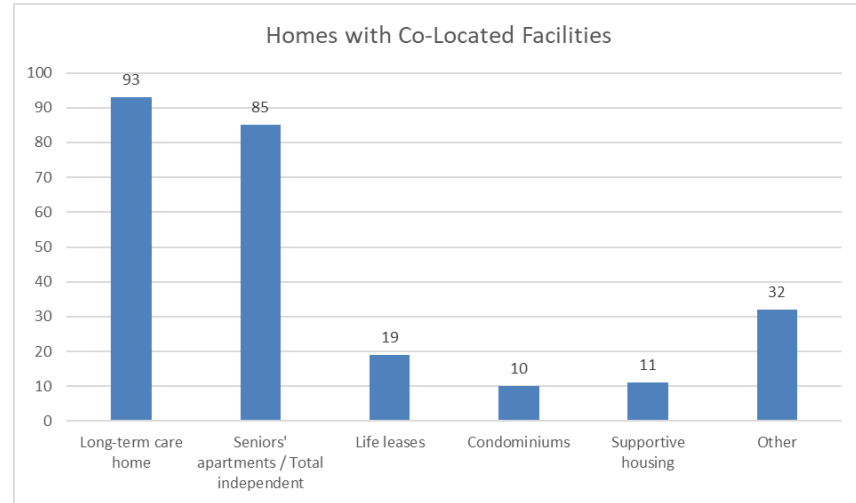
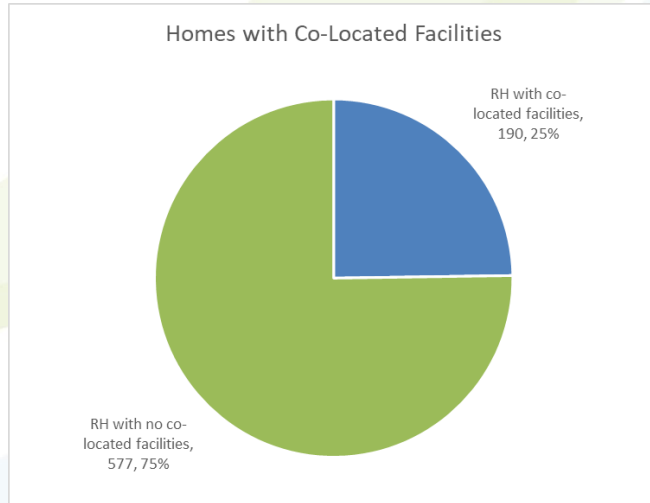
# Subsidy programs: About 1/4 of homes have other funding programs

Question:

Is the retirement home located on the same premises as any of the following facilities that do not meet the definition of a retirement home? (picklist provided – see *Homes with Co-Located Facilities* graph)
